Subject: **Extension in date of filing/e-filing of Income Tax Returns/ Statements.**

In view of the prevalent situation in the country and in order to facilitate filing/e-filing of income tax returns/statements, time period available upto December 31, 2009 is extended further upto January 25, 2010.

2. This extended time period shall be available only for those Corporate cases where **tax due to be paid alongwith the return is deposited by December 31, 2009.**

3. Income Tax Returns/Statements in cases of non-filers/short filers individuals/AOPs may also be filed by depositing the tax payable alongwith the returns/statements by **January 25, 2010.**

4. Penalties, additional tax and prosecution shall, therefore, not be attracted in cases where income tax returns/statements are filed/e-filed accordingly by the extended date i.e. **January 25, 2010**, if the conditions mentioned above are fulfilled.

5. **Relevant branches of State Bank of Pakistan and National Bank of Pakistan will remain open to receive tax payments upto 08:00 p.m., and all Inland Revenue Regional Tax Offices and Large Taxpayer Units will remain open till 9:00 p.m. on December 31, 2009.**
