Under the Constitution of Pakistan, Sales tax on services has historically remained a Provincial domain which led to promulgations of Sales Tax on Services Ordinances, simultaneously each Province in the year 2000 levy taxes on few services. Later on other services were also added through other modes like Federal Excise etc. The chargeability of sales tax remained with Provinces, but the assessment and collection powers were assigned to FBR.

After constitutional reforms through 18th amendment in the Constitution of Pakistan and consensus developed among the Federation and provinces on sales tax on services being entirely provincial domain, the Government of Sindh took initiative and promulgated Sindh Sales Tax on Services Act, 2011. Then the Government of Punjab promulgated Punjab Sales Tax on Services Act, 2012 we.f July 01, 2012 and now Government of KPK promulgated KPK Finance Act, 2013 applicable w.e.fJuly 01, 2013.

The provinces are increasing day by day the scope of chargeability of sales tax on services by adding new services in the lix of taxable services.

Currently Punjab, Sindh and KPK Governments are collecting sales tax on services provided, rendered, initiated, received and consumed in

PUNJAB, Sindh and KPK respectively. Telecommunication, Hotels, restaurants, clubs/caterers, marriage halls, Advertisements, Custom Agents, Courier services, Banking and nonbanking services, Insurance and Stock Brokers' services are the common taxable service in these provinces but Punjab and Sindh Governments has increased their list of taxable services time by time by inserting construction, Information Technology, Consultancy, Property, Beauty Parlors/Clinics, Manpower, Security, business support, fashion designing, rent a car etc. The workshop aims at to review, discuss and understand the salient features of Punjab, Sindh and KPK Sales tax on services, and their implication in between Punjab / Sindh / KPK, Baluchistan and Islamabad Capital Territory. At the end of the session the participants will be able to handle their day to day matters relevant to provincial sales tax transactions and to make changes required in their existing taxation system in a professional manner.
